CDAO Mission and Functions

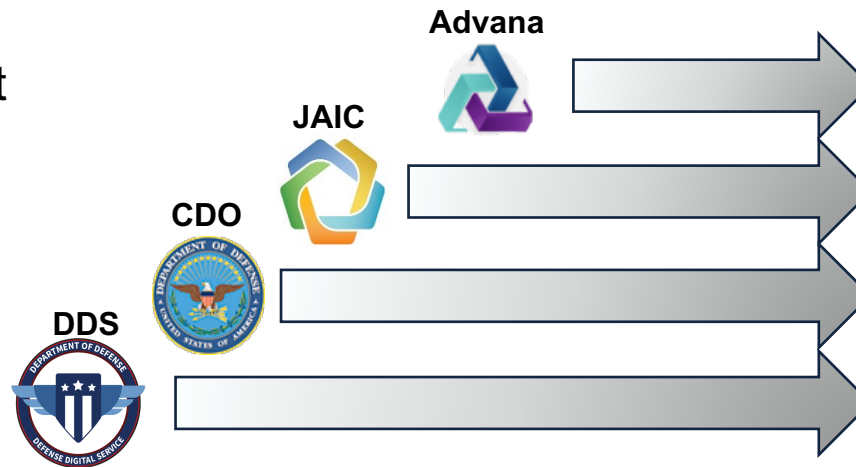
Mission:

Accelerate DoD's adoption of data, analytics, and AI to generate decision advantage boardroom to the battlefield

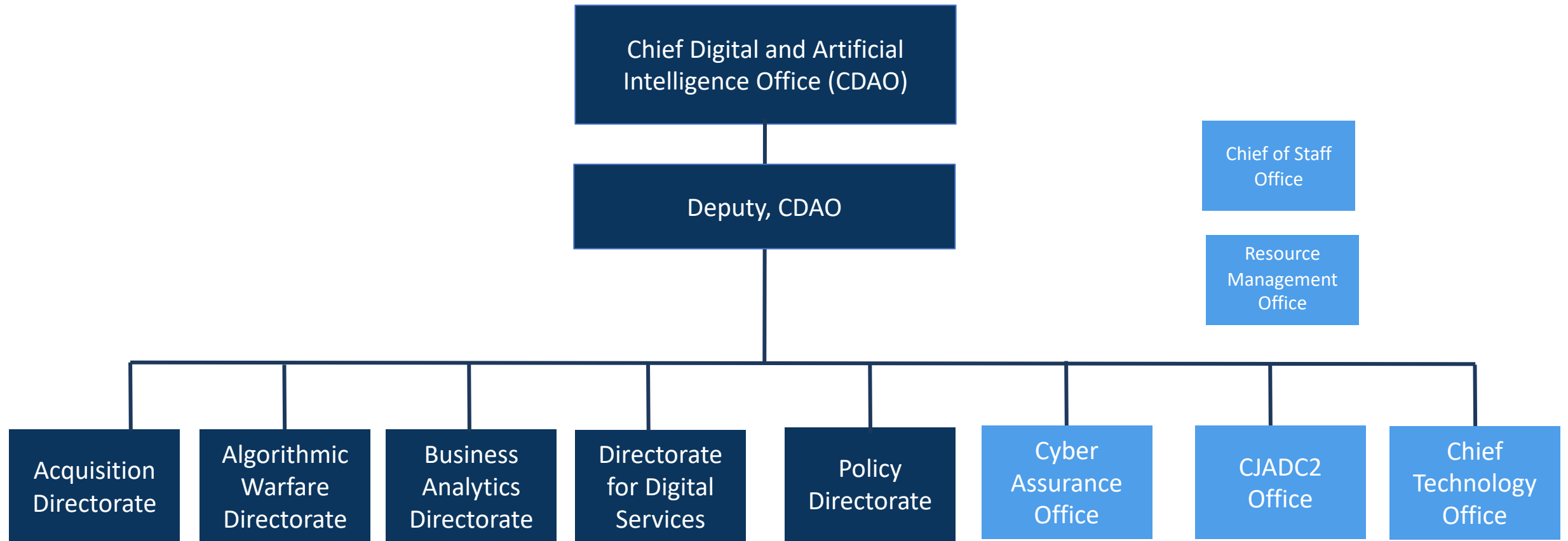
Functions:

- 1. Lead and oversee** DoD's strategy development and policy formulation for data, analytics, and AI.
- 2. Break down barriers** to data and AI adoption within DoD institutional processes (serve as a "demanding customer").
- 3. Create enabling digital infrastructure and services** that support Components' development and deployment of data, analytics, AI, and digital-enabled solutions.

- 4. Selectively scale** proven digital and AI-enabled solutions for enterprise and joint use cases.
- 5. Surge digital services** for rapid response to crises and emergent challenges.



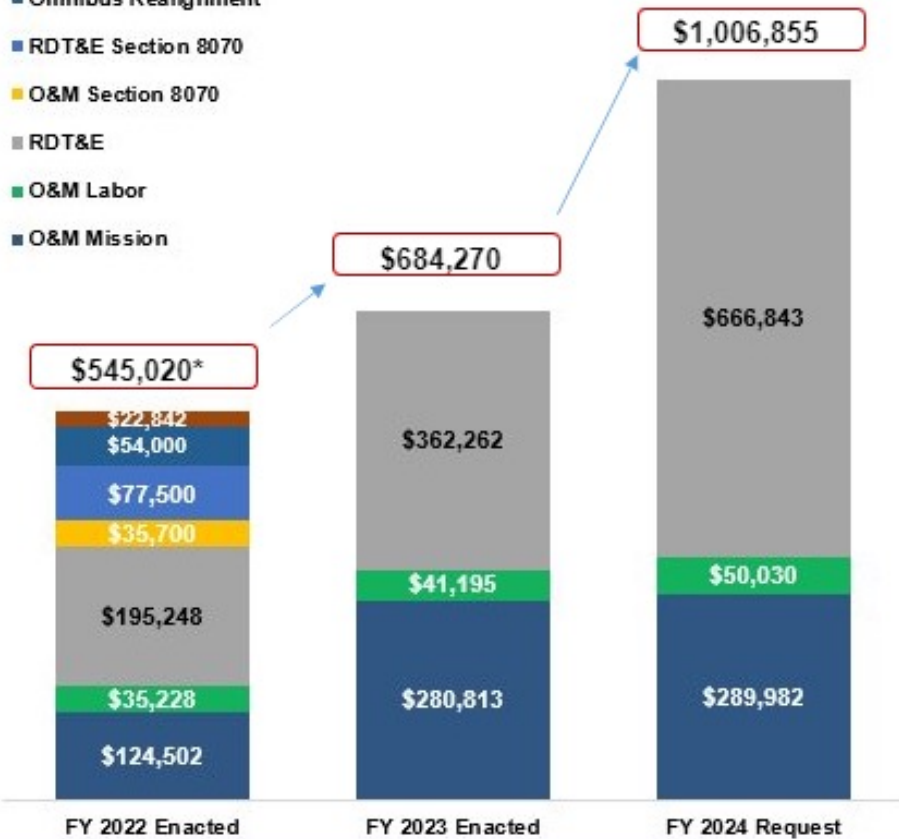
CDAO Organization



CDAO Budget & Strategic Priorities

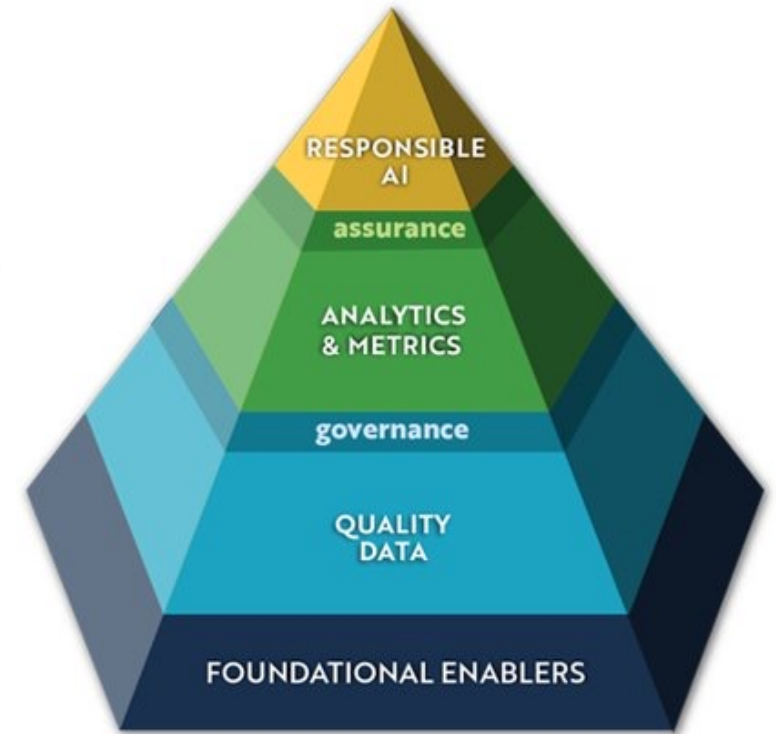
CDAO Budget Profile (\$K)

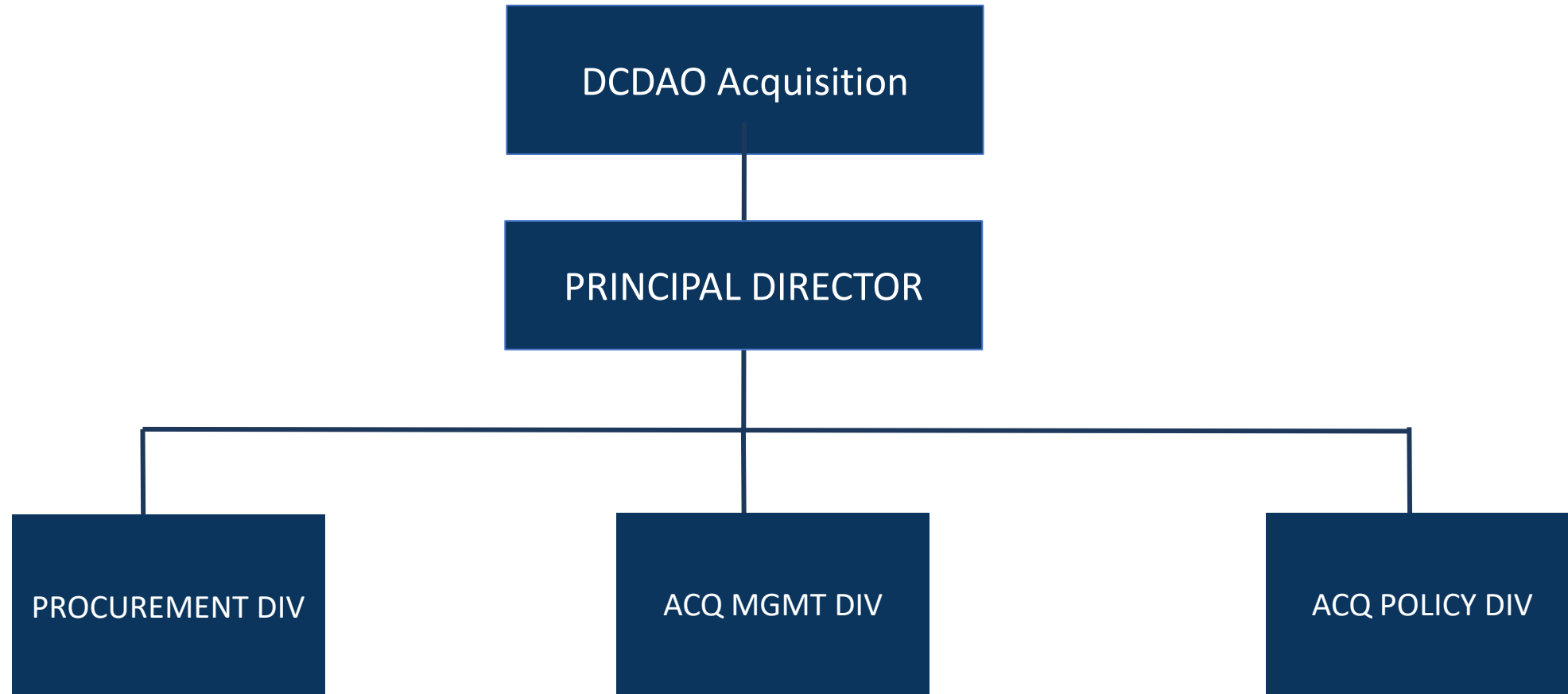

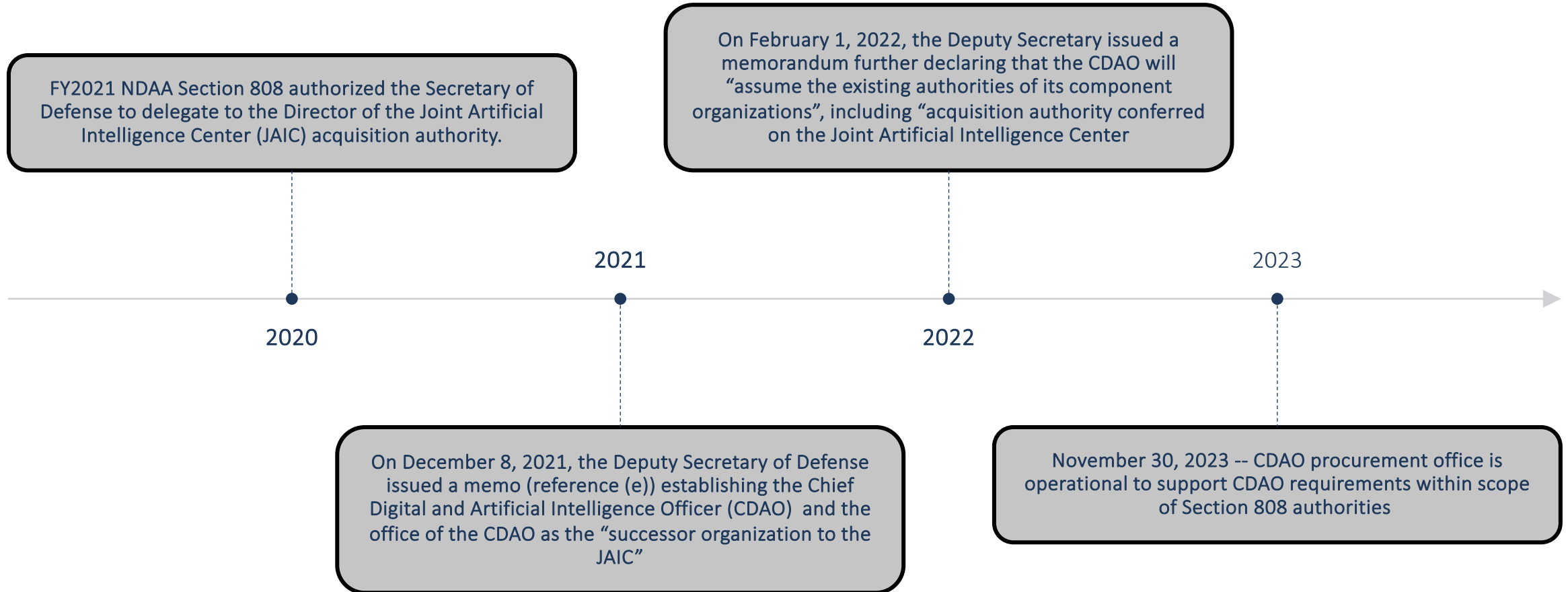

Acquisitions Directorate Mission and Functions

Mission: Develop rapid, innovative, enduring, and effective acquisition and procurement solutions to CDAO and the Department to support agile delivery of digital and AI capabilities.

Functions:

- Provide oversight and charter CDAO program/project managers, as required, support development of sound acquisition plan and strategy, approve acquisition Strategies and Simplified Acquisition Management Plans, monitor and approve program baselines for deviations to ensure CDAO digital and AI capabilities are developed with sufficient programmatic rigor, IAW statutory and regulatory requirements;
- Provide tailored, innovative contracting capabilities using multiple acquisition authorities; create agreements between CDAO, industry, government entities, and academic institutions to accelerate the development of digital and AI capabilities; and
- Serve as the Acquisition Workforce career manager for the CDAO and senior digital and AI advisor for USD A&S.

FY24 Objectives

- Execute and expand CDAO Acquisition Authority
- Operationalize CDAO Procurement Office
- Implement defense acquisition program management execution with appropriate rigor
- Accelerate delivery of AI/ML, digital, and data solutions through Tradewinds to expand innovative procurement offerings
- Implement and institutionalize novel contracting strategies for procurement of emerging technologies
- Baseline, prioritize, and implement CDAO Enterprise Standards
